The European Care Certificate (ECC) is a transnational system for the recognition and implementation of an entry level qualification for social care staff in Europe. The ECC has been developed with Leonardo da Vinci funding using the experience and expertise from a number of organisations in the social care sector in six countries of the EU (Austria, Belgium, Germany, Portugal, Romania and the United Kingdom). At this final conference the ECC will be presented to a wider audience. We intend to expand the ECC to be available to employers, service providers, workers and training providers in the social care sector in all countries of the EU.
